National Broadcast

Our National Broadcast was hosted by Kathy Branzell and Tim Tebow at the Museum of the Bible and in the United States Capitol. Through our partnerships with Christian ministry and media leaders including Waterstone, Daystar, GOD TV, NRBTV, CBN News, CTN, TLN Media, Revelation TV, Bott Radio Network, Salem Communications, and many other national and local networks and stations, we reached out to 195 countries with the message of HOPE, a call to prayer for America, and a clear presentation of the Gospel. Together, we impacted nearly **110 million homes in U.S.** and over **2.2 billion people around the world.**

Congressional Observance

The National Day of Prayer Congressional Observance was held this year on Capitol Hill. As millions gathered across our nation in prayer within their local communities, government leaders from the U.S. House and Senate hosted hundreds in the Cannon House Caucus Room who lifted up our nation together in prayer. Every prayer that was poured out pointed everyone gathered to the God of HOPE, asking Him to pour out His HOPE and healing upon our land. The observance was also streamed live on X (formerly Twitter), allowing thousands more across the nation to join in prayer and worship in real time.

National Leadership Summit

In September, over 150 National Day of Prayer leaders from across the nation gathered at the Museum of the Bible and in the U.S. Capitol, where we were all challenged to ABOUND in the Lord Jesus Christ. Our sessions were spent hearing our staff and our National Area Leaders equipping and encouraging our state and local coordinators, and praying and planning to mobilize our communities in unified public prayer for America. Our new theme for 2026 was revealed along with the theme art featuring an image from the painting, *The Prayer at Valley Forge*. Elizabeth Carlyle, CEO of the First Freedom Art Company who owns the painting, shared her excitement to partner with the National Day of Prayer Task Force on this coming **75th National Day of Prayer during our nation's 250th anniversary**. Pouring Out to the God of Hope ...

The “Glory Stories” each year shine as powerful reminders that when God’s people pour out their prayers to Him, He faithfully pours out His presence, power, and hope in return. They remind us that the National Day of Prayer **is not the culmination, but the catalyst** – a spark that ignites a continual outpouring of prayer throughout the year.



While many Junior High students would normally spend their lunch period chatting about upcoming tests, worrying about homework assignments, or catching up on text messages, 61 ninth graders in Ada, Oklahoma took time out of their lunch period to participate in the National Day of Prayer. The Prayer at Valley Forge

This year's theme art incorporates an image from ***The Prayer at Valley Forge***, a poignant portrayal of General George Washington during one of the most critical moments in the American Revolution. Amidst the immense hardships and isolation faced by the Continental Army, Washington is depicted in a moment of solitary prayer, desperately seeking guidance and strength.

Painted by American artist, Arnold Friberg, R.S.A, (1913-2010). A humble man, he once explained: *"I don't want anyone to notice the artist. I want them to notice the art. Art to me is a service, to bring enrichment to people's lives. The picture comes to me, taps me on the shoulder, and tells me it has selected me. So, I don't create anything; I follow what is given to me."*
